

Maths

Multiplication & Division, and Length & Perimeter –

We will recap and introduce new times tables. The children will learn how to multiply two-digit numbers by one digit, and how to divide dividends that leave a remainder. They will convert measurements between metres, centimetres, and millimetres, and find the perimeters of simple polygons.

Music
