

## MATHS

Our topics this term are multiplication and division; length and perimeter; fractions; and mass and capacity. The children will learn how to multiply two-digit numbers by one digit, and how to divide dividends that leave a remainder. When we study length, we will look at measuring in mm, cm and metres, and learn how to find perimeters. With fractions, we will compare and order unit fractions and start to find equivalent fractions on a number line.

Europe will learn songs from the 'Charanga' music scheme.

## SCIENCE
