

Maths

Time - Learning how to tell the time to the nearest minute, using digital and analogue clocks.

Money - Adding and subtracting money, finding change and converting pounds into pence.

Properties of Shape - Looking at turns and angles, comparing angles, horizontal and vertical lines, parallel and perpendicular lines, recognising and describing two dimensional shapes.

Music

Asia will be learning the violin., looking at note annotation, pulse and rhythm.

Europe will be following the Year 3 Charanga curriculum.

PSHCE

Growing & Changing - We will discuss the difference between secrets and surprises, how to stay safe online and signals our body gives us. We will be looking how our bodies being to change and starting periods.

Science

Plants - The functions of different parts of the plant. How plants reproduce and spread their seeds, how we use plants in everyday life, growing seeds in different conditions.

Hope - we will look at stories where hope is shown and how this value is important. Adults and children within the year group will lead the worship.

Art

Plant Art - Art inspired by plants. Making observational drawings of plants, creating different tints, tones and shades of colours, making cardboard prints and clay sculptures.

PE

Athletics - Sports day preparation, running, skipping and jumping

Computing

Robots - Using multi-step instructions to change a robot's colour, make it make the correct noise and move in the correct direction.

Literacy

Letters - We will be writing letters to the local council about issues in our local area.

Explanation Texts - We will be looking at explaining how school has changed over time.

Narrative - We will be reading classic tales, such as The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe. The children will be writing their own narrative tales.

Shape & Haiku poetry -

Using similes, metaphors, adjectives and describing our senses to create poems. Drafting these poems and writing them into shapes. A Haiku is a traditional form of Japanese poetry that consists of three lines with a syllable pattern of 5-7-5.
