Monday	<p>Maths Spring term Week 2 Maths lessons from White Rose Watch the video and then complete the worksheet which has been emailed to you on Purple Mash. Daily Maths starter on PM Extension task on PM</p>	<p>Literacy Serial Mash – follow the story for your class and complete the comprehension activity.</p> <p>SPAG: Expanded noun phrases on BBC Bitesize.</p> <p>Spellings: Purple Mash Spring 1 Week 1. The list for the week is in your class Purple Mash folder, along with a 2Do activity. On Friday, test yourself on the 'Test' 2Do. Note: This will not be available until Friday.</p> <p>Collective Worship: Our Christian Value for this term is Wisdom. What does it mean to be wise? Who do you know who is wise? Share your ideas on the Year 5 Blog in Purple Mash or make some notes of your own.</p>	<p>Literacy Join the live lesson 2pm Before the lesson, listen to or read the story of Oliver Twist up to chapter 6. Look at the example description of Fagin. We will work together to write our own description of this character.</p> <p>Music Space themed music: Listen to Mars from The Planet Suite by Holst. Pause the video when this piece finishes. Write some words that describe how the music makes you feel. How has the composer created that mood (what instruments, pitch, rhythm, tempo etc). Now continue the video to listen to Venus. Describe how this music makes you feel. How has this mood been created? Find out about the Roman gods, Mars and Venus and also the planets named after them. Can you spot any links between the planets, the gods and the music? Try using Busy Beats in Purple Mash to create two pieces of music with some contrasting moods. This also links with our Science for this week so be ready to share what you have learnt in the live lesson on Wednesday. Learn a song to sing Sing Up Youtube channel. There is a livestream lesson every Tuesday at 9am but videos are available at any time.</p>
