Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Daily [White Rose](#) Maths lessons – these lessons follow what we will be doing in school. Watch the video and then complete the questions in the video.
- Choose a daily problem-solving activity on [NRich](#)
- Complete daily maths lessons on bitesize. [BBC Bitesize](#)
- Play on [Times Table Rock Stars](#).
- Play [Hit the Button](#) - focus on times tables, division facts and squared numbers.
- Daily [arithmetic](#) for different areas of maths. Work on level 4, 5 and 6 activities and try to focus on fractions.

Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 short task per day)

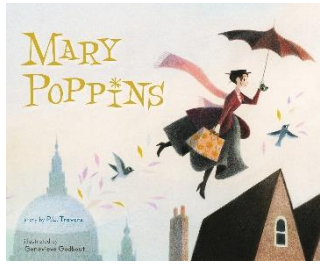


Year 6 Home-school unit: The Gadgets Workbook
