

Home Learning (Year 2 – Term 3 Week 2)

Age Range: Year 2

Purple Mash

Please ensure that you check your Purple Mash regularly for any emails or resources. Please note that the red notification symbol on the purple 'Alerts' bell is no longer active – you will need to click on the bell ('Alerts') for any notifications including comments from your teacher on submitted work. You can click '2Dos' for any new set. If you click on 'Work', then use the arrow drop-downs to select your class, then you can find your own folder where you can save things.

In year 2, we will be communicating the links to some of our teaching videos via your child's Purple Mash email, so please do check these to keep up to date. Work is to be submitted in your child's individual folder.

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
 Get your child to play on <u>Times Table Rockstars</u>. Allow your child to play on <u>Hit the Button</u> - Focus on times tables (2,5 and 10) and Number Bonds. Play on <u>Top Marks Daily 10</u> Level 2 - Focus on Multiplication. Daily Maths Tasks are also being set on <u>Purple Mash</u>: The children will need access to Purple Mash, writing equipment e.g. pencil and paper or whiteboard and pen and objects that they can group or count e.g. pasta shapes, cubes, toy cars, coins, colouring pencils or Lego etc. Day 1: LO - To make multiplication sentences from pictures. PPT & Activity – The children will use the multiplication symbol and work out the total from given pictures. Day 2: LO - To use arrays. Flip Grid Video Activity – Practical – The children will use the array made. Day 3: LO - To make doubles. Flip Grid Video Activity – To use their knowledge of doubles to complete the worksheet. Day 4: LO - Z x Tables. 	 Day 1: LO - To write a character description about the alien who crash landed. There will be a live lesson on Teams with Miss Parsons at 11am. You will be sent a link via your Purple Mash email. Day 2: LO - To write sentences using expanded noun phrases. There will be a live lesson on Teams with Mrs Talbot at 11am. You will be sent a link via your Purple Mash email. Day 3: LO - To choose appropriate vocabulary. Create a word bank of alien adjectives/WOW words to help you improve your character descriptions. Can you think of some really interesting ones? Perhaps you can practise using a thesaurus to improve your adjectives. Day 4: LO - To extend sentences with a conjunction. Rewrite some of your sentences from Day 2 or create some new ones using a conjunction. Conjunctions: and, or, but, if, because, so, when. These will extend the sentence to give it more detail e.g. The alien has black, beady eyes and huge teeth. The alien has 8, slimy, long legs so it can run very fast.

PPT & Activity - Children will use pictorial representations to help them count in twos progressing to completing number tracks. Weekly Spellings	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
 Look, say, write, cover, check weekly spellings have been set on Purple Mash. Encourage your child to practise the Year 2 Common Exception Words Download at: Oxford Owl Then ask your child to choose 5 Common Exception words. They can do some rainbow writing by writing over the top of the word in various coloured pencils to get used to rewriting these words. Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. Following this, ask your child to summarise the events from the chapter. They could bullet point what happened, create a comic strip or present the information in their own creative way. Direct your child to Love Reading. Ask them to explore the Book of the Month and previous books of the month. How many have they read?

Topic Learning Projects – to be done throughout the week.

Topic:

Art/ DT:

Investigate the toys that you have in your house. Can any of them move? Investigate how they move (push a button, pull back and release, push along etc). Set up an experiment to see which travels furthest along the floor from a fixed starting point.

Science:

Think carefully about what seed dispersal means and watch this <u>video</u>. Draw and name each of the 7 methods of seed dispersal and what happens. For parents - hooked by animals, drop and roll, animal burial, soft fruit dispersal, wind dispersal, spinning dispersal, carried by water, exploding plants.
