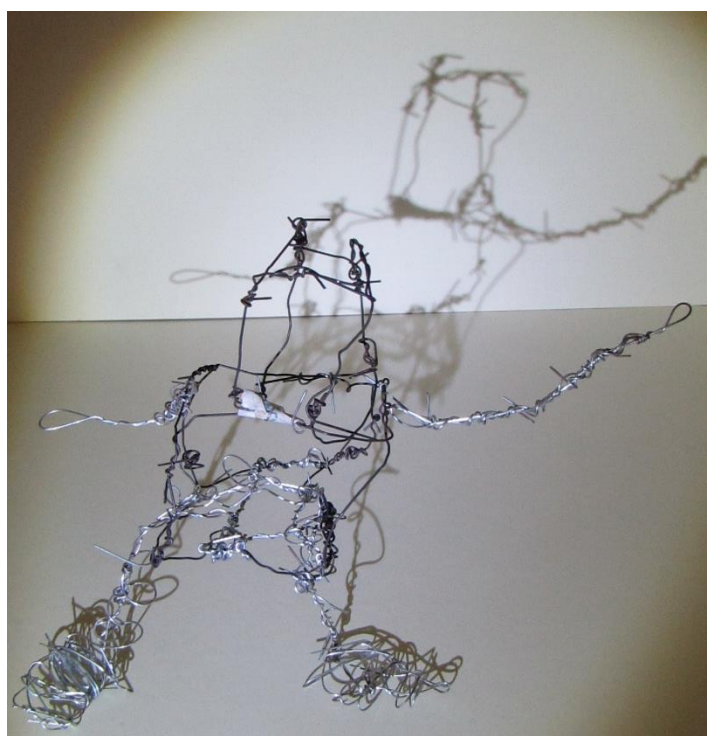
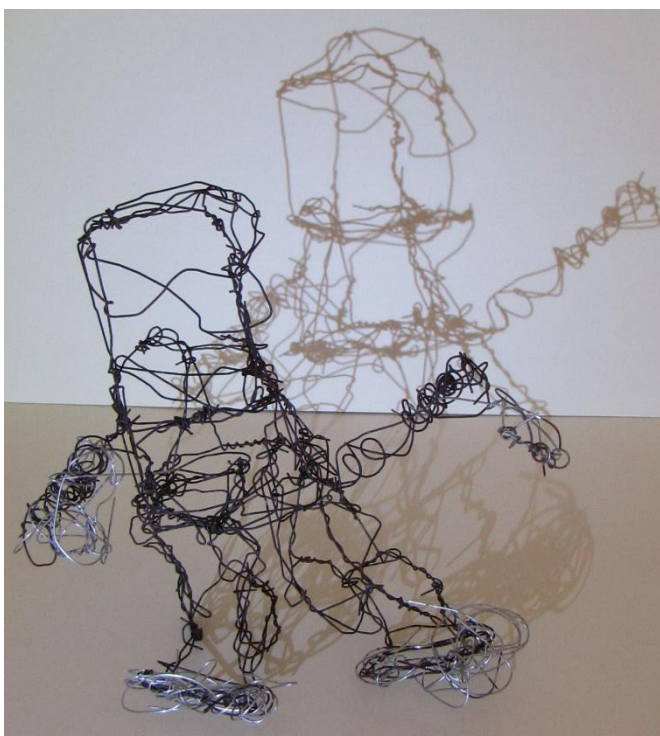
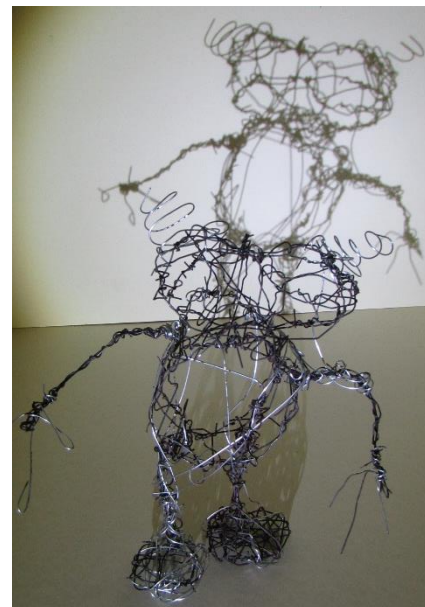
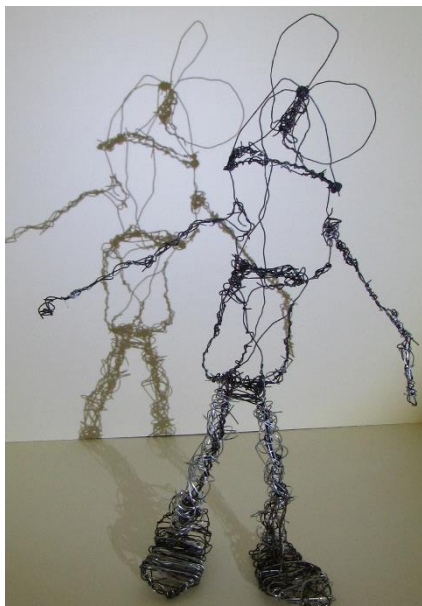
KS2B:

Pupils looked at how different artists depicted figures in art and created drawings and sculptures inspired by Julian Opie

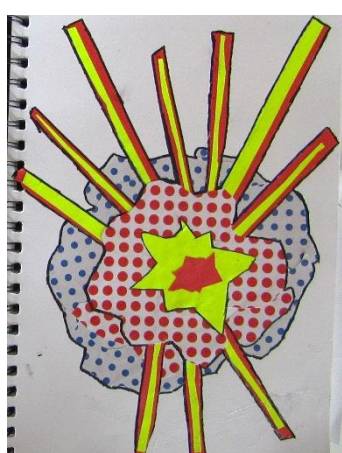
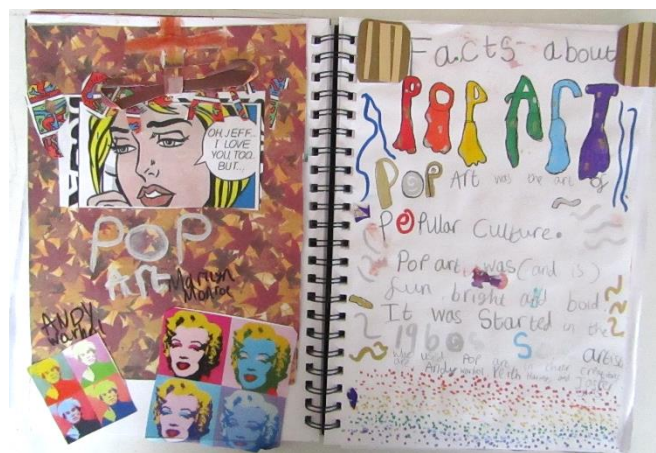
