<u>Curriculum Evening/Meet the Teacher Evening – 21st September 2022</u>

Dear parents and carers,

We are delighted to invite all our parents to 'St Anne's Curriculum Evening/Meet the Teacher Evening' on Wednesday 21st September. The purpose of the evening is to provide an opportunity to share the success of the previous year's attainment outcomes and also explain the school's focus for the year ahead. In previous years we have split the evening into two parts and this has proved time efficient. One part of the evening will be a 20 minute presentation by the Headteacher in the KS2 Hall, with the other part of the evening being a 30 minute opportunity to meet with your child's class teacher in your child's classroom. Class teachers will share curriculum information and individual class routines with parents. If you have children in both EYFS/KS1 and KS2, I would advise you to attend both teacher meetings.

Parents of children in EYFS and KS1

At 6.00pm a presentation from the Headteacher will take place in the KS2 Hall. Due to the ongoing building works, access to the KS2 Hall will be through the Library door which is located to the rear of the KS2 building. Staff will be there to guide you. All EYFS/KS1 teachers will be in the hall for this presentation and I will introduce teachers to all parents. Once the presentation has concluded, the teachers will lead parents to your child's classroom for your 'Meet the Teacher' meeting. This will begin by 6.30pm and conclude at 7.00pm.

Parents of children in KS2

At 6.oopm, 'Meet the Teacher' meetings will begin in your child's classroom. Please access the classrooms through the external blue doors that the children use at the start and end of the school day. At 6.3opm, all KS2 parents and staff are invited to move into the KS2 Hall for the Headteacher's presentation. This presentation will conclude by 7.oopm.

It is important that as many parents as possible attend as teachers will provide valuable information for the year ahead.

Collecting children after school
