### Year 1

This week in Year 1, the children have been busy learning all about *recounts* in English, with a special focus on using past-tense —ed verbs. They even wrote their very own recount of The Christmas Story and did a fantastic job. In Maths, the children have been working hard to compare numbers, confidently identifying which are greater than, less than, or equal to one another. In Science, we have been exploring the signs of winter. The children have started their own weekly weather diaries, carefully observing and recording the different changes in our winter weather. In R.E., the children enjoyed going on a tour around the school to look for signs of Christmas, spotting festive symbols and decorations along the way. Year 1 had great fun taking part in the Santa Fun Run—there were lots of smiles, festive excitement, and plenty of energy!





### Year 2

This week Year 2 have enjoyed a mixture of Christmas activities and exciting lessons! In English, we have started our poetry topic, looking at kennings and how they are structured. In Maths, we have been counting the faces, edges and vertices on 3d shapes. In Jam Coding, we created and filmed our own animations. In Music, we have performed our own musical stories. In DT we completed a taste test of different types of gingerbread; we evaluated each one and voted for our favourite! In RE, we looked at how Advent is celebrated differently around the world. During PE, we continued to work on our tennis skills and during the Santa Dash we demonstrated great determination and joy, as we completed laps

together around the playground!

decorating them next week.








### Year 4

### Year 5


