




Spotlight on Reception

Nursery We have been continuing to look at the story Jack and the Beanstalk, the "magic" purple beans that the children have planted are starting to grow, some are already stretching up to the children's castles. Year 1 This week in Year 1 as part of this terms topic 'We are Scientists' the children have enjoyed their new English theme 'instructions' on how to plant a seed. They have written their own set of instructions using time words and bossy verbs. In maths we have had a tricky challenge of making and solving arrays using rows and columns. This week we have looked at the artist 'Andy Warhol' and designed a portrait of the Queen in the style of his work 'Pop Art'. We can't wait for you to come in and see!

Year 2 In Year 2 this week the children have been learning about Pentecost Day and retold the story of the coming of the Holy Spirit.
