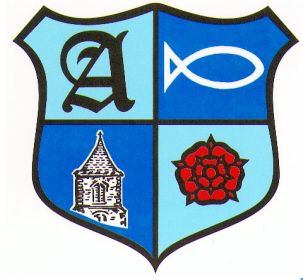

Everyone enjoyed some drinks, crisps, biscuits and cakes before

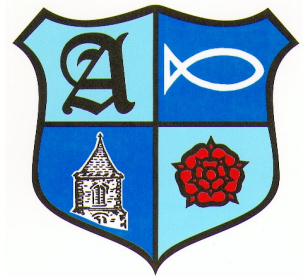


having a play out on the Junior playground.

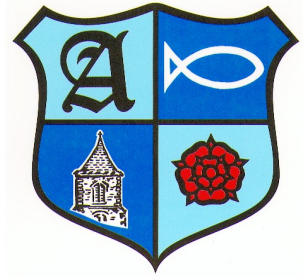

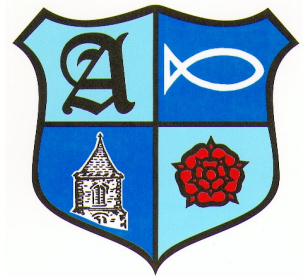
