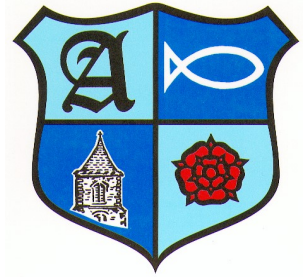

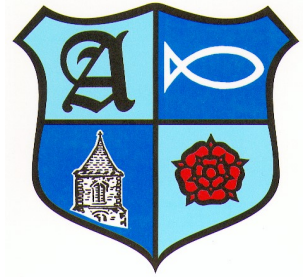

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Curriculum News

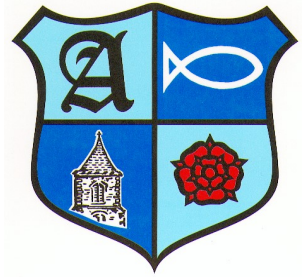
- Reception We have been so proud of the way the children have settled into school this week. Happy faces all round!
- Year 1 This week our Year One children have been practising writing sentences correctly and made a wonderful "All About Me" booklet. We have also explored how to order numbers and identify whether they are odd or even!
- Year 2 The children have had another wonderful, hard working week exploring the 'key ingredients' for a healthy body & a healthy mind. They made some fantastic information posters during their Science session to display their ideas. The children have also been immersing themselves in a variety of Traditional Tales with a Twist. They have been exploring the language and story structure needed to make a fantastic twisted tale.
- Year 3 This week Year 3 have continued to work hard on their biographies in English as well as finding out all about the Olympic Rings and their history. The children are working so hard and we're so proud of the start they have made to Year 3!
