Curriculum News

Nursery The Sparkling Stars have been very busy this week practicing for Sports day on Monday morning! We have also been talking about what our favourite songs are ready for our Graduation. We have all been working hard in our focused groups this week, recapping on what we have learnt over the year. The children from Year 3 came to visit us on Thursday and read us some stories. Thank You very much Year 3 we loved it. The Giggle Tots have been rescuing sea creatures that got suck in the ice!

Reception This week in Reception we have been exploring our outside rea. We have enjoyed picking home grown strawberries and watering our growing vegetable garden. In maths we have been learning about doubles to double 5 and in literacy we have been using adjectives to describe the Big Bad Wolf from The Three Little Pigs.

Year 1 This week, we have been learning to recognise different coins and notes, and understand their value. We've also been observing our sunflowers as they grow and have been labelling the different parts of the sunflower.





