Reception This week we have been learning about materials. Our writing groups have focused on writing sentences about materials and their properties. We finished off our Good News RE topic this week with a very prayerful celebration collective worship.

Year 1 A busy week in Year 1 writing our own information booklet about the Titanic using our previous knowledge that we have learnt to write some interesting facts. The children created beautiful sunflowers in Art inspired by Vincent Van Gogh's artwork using oil pastels. We have started our D.T topic this week learning all about moving vehicles and what features they have. We can't wait to create our own!

Year 2 This week has been a very busy week in Year 2. We are so proud of the children for all their hard work, and super learning behaviour.
