In Reception this week we have been reading the story of The Three Little Pigs. We thought of adjectives to describe the Big Bad Wolf then used them to create an amazing sentence.



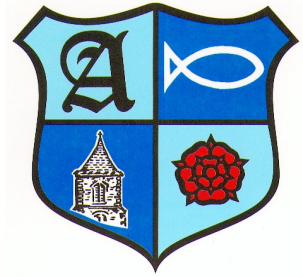
In maths this week we have been learning about repeating patterns and positional language. We created scenes for The Three Little Pigs and used positional language to describe the scene to our friends and teachers.

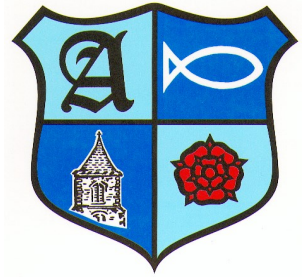

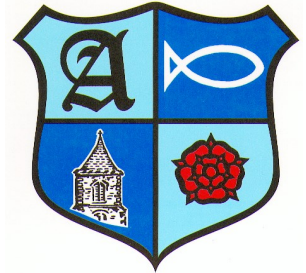
Year 5 Year 5 have been thoroughly enjoying preparing for and going on their camping expedition.

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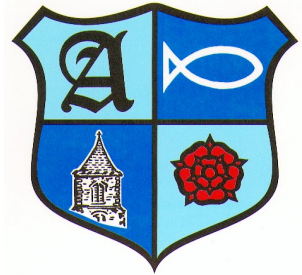

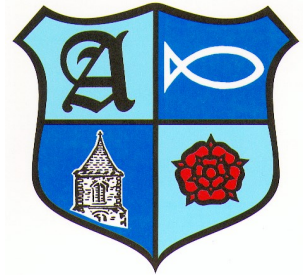
