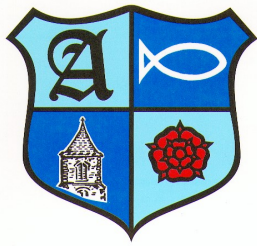

Curriculum News

Nursery The children have had an exciting week in Nursery this week, the Sparkling Stars have been to visit their new teachers in Reception and the Giggle Tots have made new friends who will be joining us in September. We have also been very busy having lots of fun, consolidating all we have learnt this year through different activities.

Reception In Reception this week we have been writing about our hopes and dreams for the future. In music we have been sorting and playing tuned and untuned instruments. In Understanding the World we have been comparing transport from the past with the present day.

Year 1 Year 1 had a magical week writing their own potion instructions! They also shone on Sports Day, showing fantastic energy, teamwork, and enthusiasm in every race and activity.

Year 2 This week in Year 2, we have looked at a picture book 'Flotsam' the children all enjoyed predicting what was happening on each page. Today, we are going to write the next part of the story and carry on the adventure. In Maths, we have consolidated our learning from this year. We were also very lucky to get a sneak peak of the Year 6 play 'Matilda', which the children and staff all thought was amazing.

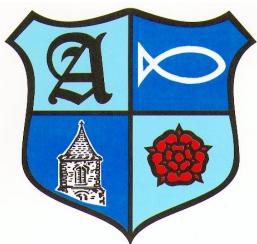

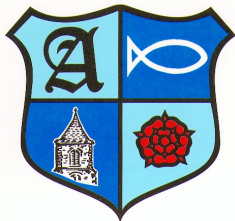

THE GOSPEL IN CHURCH
Sunday 6th July 2025

The Lord appointed another seventy-two and sent them out ahead of him, in pairs, to all the towns and places he himself was to visit. He said to them, "The harvest is rich but the labourers are few, so ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers to his harvest. Start off now, but remember, I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. Carry no purse, no haversack, no sandals. Salute no one on the road. Whatever house you go into, let your first words be, 'Peace to this house!' And if people of peace live there, your peace will go and rest on them; if not, it will come back to you. Stay in the same house, taking what food and drink they have to offer, for the labourer deserves his wages; do not move from house to house. Whenever you go into a town where they make you welcome, eat what is set before you. Cure those in it who are sick, and say, 'The Kingdom of God is very near to you.'"
