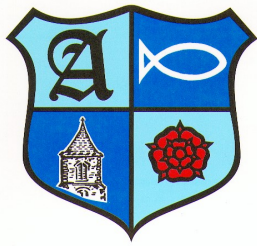

Curriculum News



Nursery The children in Nursery have been talking about what Summer means to them, the children have had lots of discussions and shared their thoughts and ideas. We have enjoyed playing the 'Ice cream game' in PE, racing each other to collect the ice creams from the cones and putting them in our bowls! the children enjoyed the experience of painting with ice, watching the colours mix!

Reception This week in Reception we have been reading *The Gingerbread Man*, we have written a new part of the story. In maths we have been learning more about 2D shapes and how to rotate them to create pictures. In Understanding the World we have learned about maps and have started to think about directions and arrows.

Year 1 We've been enjoying *Percy the Park Keeper*, learning about the main characters and key events. In Geography, we used directional language while exploring a map of our school. We've also been working hard on our phonics ready for next week's Screening Check.

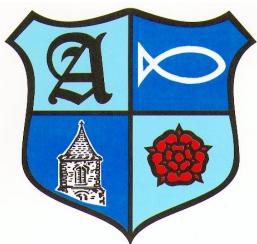
Year 2 This week in year 2, in Maths we have been looking at tally charts and pictograms to present data. In English, we have been identifying key features of instructions. In Science, We have put the instructions to use, by following them to plant our own sunflowers for our science investigation. Two of the children took part in the singing concert after school and it was lovely to see the shine.

Year 3 The Year 3 children have sewn their own bags this week. The bags included adding a button and handle, creating fantastic end products that they were very proud of. The children have been focusing on Time in maths and features of a play script in English.

Year 4 The children have made a fantastic start to their final half term in Year 4. They have approached their Multiplication Times Table Check in a mature manner and we are very proud of them. We enjoyed being back on the tennis courts this week, focusing on our serving and rallies. We look forward to continuing our class text, 'Eye of The Wolf' in English.

Year 5 Year 5 have been learning about the legacy of Ancient Greece and what it has given us - we found out how the Olympics began in 776BC with one sprint race and then it has ballooned into our present billion pound business. We finished our topic on golf - some of us were superb drivers, but we need more care with our putting. In Maths we have started looking at negative numbers in the area of temperature. In Science we have looked at pulleys and gears - we will use that knowledge to build models next week.

Year 6 As they enter their final half term in St Anne's, the Year 6 children have had a busy week! Both classes took part in a locomotive workshop. On Thursday we held auditions for our end of year play - very exciting and today the children have been treated to many different career talks! Thank you to all those who came in to talk to the children!

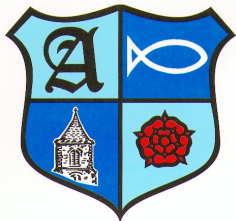

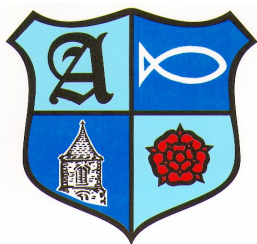
