

**Spotlight on Year 2!**

This week we have been reading stories from Janet & Allan Ahlberg's 'Funny Bones' series and used their ideas to inspire our poetry writing. We have innovated our own ideas, written them in verses, used rhyming couplets and added a few exclamation marks too. Amazing!

We also used Big Skeleton & Little Skeleton to inspire our Design Technology project. We made our own skeletons with moving parts and positioned them using ideas from the text. We loved Big Skeleton playing 'Boo!'

The whole school have been studying 'Judaism' in our 'Other Faiths' week. In Year 2 we have discovered lots about the Jewish special day - Shabbat. We have made challah bread, designed a special cover for the bread, made 6 wick candles called havdalah candles and designed a spice box that the Jewish people use to smell at the end of Shabbat. The children have amazed us with their wonderful responses!



## **ENDEAVOUR HOLIDAY CAMP**

West Lancashire Sport Partnership will again be providing an Endeavour Holiday Camp at St. Anne's this October half-term.

The camp is running for 5 days from Monday 26th - Friday 30th October, from 8.30am to 3.30pm.

Please see the details below provided by West Lancashire Sport Partnership:

- **You will be able to book your child/children in for a Monday & Tuesday bubble (2 days), Wednesday, Thursday & Friday bubble (3 days), or the full week (both bubbles), but not individual days.**
  - **There will be separate KS1 and KS2 groups, which will both be a maximum size of 15.**
  - **These groups will remain as the same bubbles on Monday & Tuesday, and then change on Wednesday, Thursday & Friday. If you book for a week, your child will be in the same group, but will be in 2 different bubbles across the 5 days.**
- £30.00 for Mon & Tues bubble, £45.00 for Wed, Thurs & Fri bubble, or £75.00 for week, payable by credit/debit card at link to be provided next week**

The government's guidelines have been published, updated for October provision. WLSP's arrangement goes beyond government recommendations to ensure greater consistency within bubbles, given the local COVID-19 case rate. WLSP will adapt to any short-notice measures the government decide need implementing for October. This may mean reducing group sizes at the last minute (anyone affected would receive a full refund). If even tighter national measures were introduced, such as a full lockdown, every parent would receive a full refund.
