DfE Guidance and Information - Christmas Contact Tracing

Public Health England has agreed a six day window after the final day of teaching in which schools and further education providers are asked to remain contactable so they can assist with contact tracing where necessary. Beyond six days after the final day of teaching, school and further education staff are not asked to play a role in any contact tracing.

End of term contact tracing arrangements

Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

For the first six days after teaching ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.

Where pupils are required to self-isolate due to contact with a positive case after the first six days following the end of term, schools do not need to be informed about their absence until the first day of the new term. Thank you.
