In school this week.....

Nursery

The children have been very busy this week! They have enjoyed making the most of the lovely weather, spending lots of time outdoors and playing happily with their friends. We have also made several visits to the Reception class in preparation for September. The children have been very excited about these visits and are showing great enthusiasm as they get ready for the next step in their learning journey. We were also delighted to celebrate Coco's birthday on the field, where the children enjoyed lots of fun games and activities together. It was a wonderful way to mark the special occasion and created many happy memories for everyone.



Reception

This week in Reception, we have continued learning about rainbows and enjoyed reading *Somebody Swallowed Stanley*. The children created fantastic posters to persuade people not to put plastic into the ocean, helping them understand the importance of looking after our environment. In PE, we practised our football skills, and we had lots of fun bouncing on the inflatable obstacle course kindly provided by JAM Coding. In maths, we explored maps and learned how they help us find our way. We also enjoyed spending time with our wonderful Year 6 buddies, sharing stories, games, and smiles together. It has been another busy and exciting week of learning!





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Year 3

We have had a busy week in Year 3. We've been creating Islamic patterns as part of the RE 'Dialogue and Encounters' topic, understanding data in Statistics during Maths, plus writing a persuasive piece of writing about whether children should wear a school uniform. In Geography we have been comparing Ormskirk to Nice in the south of France, and learning about the similarities and differences to the schooling, whilst on Wednesday we held our 'Stay and Pray' sessions.

We began the week with an assembly delivered by Elizabeth from Ormskirk Library about the Summer Reading challenge and on Tuesday enjoyed a fantastic performance of 'Cinderella' by Year 6! On Thursday, we were treated to some inflatable fun from JAM Coding and then ended the week with a fabulous end of year celebration from our wonderful PTA. 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Year 5

This week, Year 5 have been researching Greek salads and making pitta bread (see photo) - it was gorgeous. We have designed our own salads and next Monday we are making them in class - it will be interesting to see if any of them are edible. In PE we have been playing cricket and learning to hit the ball away from the fielders and in Boxercise, we have been learning power shots, whilst keeping our guard up. In RE we have been learning about how God made the world and how He made us stewards of it - serious stuff!
