Curriculum News

Reception Please see this week's spotlight.

- Year One, although at home, are busy designing and creating fruit kebabs as part of our Design and Technology topic! We are also using Class Charts to hear our teachers reading a daily story!
- Year 2 This week we have been writing our innovated version of the Katie Morag adventure 'Delivers the Mail.' We are brilliant at using the joining word 'when' in our sentences.

We are continuing to learn and understand our 2-, 5- and 10-times tables using arrays, repeated addition, and rapid recall. We are growing in confidence (and speed!).

In Phonics we have been using and applying our knowledge of the alternative spellings of different phonemes by creating rhyming strings. We have also been working extremely hard on sounding out real and alien words.

- Year 3 The wonderful Year 3 children have been looking at maps and fact files on Europe and Ormskirk, whilst studying fables ready to write our own next week. Next week we are also looking at time can all children wear watches if they have them?
- Year 4 This week Year 4 have been creating their own pieces of art inspired by Gerard Sekoto and the apartheid law.
- Year 5 have been writing non-chronological reports comparing Early Iraq and especially Baghdad to the present day. Their knowledge is amazing and has made their Teachers very proud.
- Year 6 This week in Year 6 we have started to complete tasks linked to our class novel 'Running Wild.' Already the children have produces some fantastic writing.
