Communication & Language

We will continue to develop our

communication skills.

We will use a wider range of vocabulary.

We will understand 'why' questions.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will begin to find solutions to conflicts and rivalries.

We will talk with others to solve conflicts.

We will understand gradually how others might be feeling.

We will look forward to starting school and talking about our feelings towards this.

Understanding the World

We will use all our senses in hands on exploration of natural materials.

We will explore materials with similar or different properties.

We will talk about what we see using a wider vocabulary

We will explore how things work.

We will explore and talk about different forces they can feel.

We will know that there are different countries in the World.

Physical Development

We will continue to develop our

movement, balancing, riding and ball skills.

We will use our developing skills to

complete tasks.

We will choose the right resources to carry a plan.

We will collaborate with others to manage large items.

<u>Maths</u>

We will solve real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5.

We will make compare quantities using language 'more than', 'fewer than'.

Make comparisons between objects relating to weight.

We will describe a familiar route and understand position through words alone.

Expressive Arts & Design

We will use drawings to represent ideas.

We will create or improvise our own songs around one we know.

We will play instruments with increasing control to express feelings and ideas.

We will develop our own ideas and decide which recyclable materials to use to express them.

We will join different materials and explore different textures.

<u>Phonics</u>

We continue to consolidate Phase 2 sounds and recognition and read and write simple CVC words.

Key Vocabulary

Mini beasts- names of different mini beasts, parts of a mini beast (legs, antennae)

Sea —names of different creatures, sea weed, coral, ship wreck, pirates, ship, telescope, flag.

Summer- Weather, Protect, sun cream, sun glasses, hat, holidays, travel, country, modes of transport

Eco-Warriors-Recycle, tidy, litter

Let's try this at home

Look in your gardens for any mini beasts, draw pictures of what you find.

Talk about sun safety at home.

Encourage children to use recycle bins.

Practice phase 2 phonics and number recognition and problem solving to encourage confidence.
