This term we will be studying the three themes of Local Church (Community), Eucharist (Relating) and Lent/Easter (Giving). Each class will approach the themes through different topics. Nursery, Reception and Years 1-3 will be continuing with the new R.E. curriculum that covers; Galilee to Jerusalem and Desert to Garden.

LOCAL CHURCH - COMMUNITY

(Spring 1)

Early Years	GALILEE TO JERUSALEM – Wise men visiting Jesus
Year 1	GALILEE TO JERUSALEM – Jesus showing love and kindness to those on the edges of society, especially little children.
Year 2	GALILEE TO JERUSALEM – Jesus teaches about the nature of God through parables and miracles
Year 3	GALILEE TO JERUSALEM – The Kingdom of God through parables and miracles
Year 4	COMMUNITY - Life in the local Christian community and ministries in the parish
Year 5	MISSION - Continuing Jesus' mission in diocese (ecumenism)
Year 6	SOURCES - The Bible, the special book for the Church

SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Explore the Diocesan website, looking at the number of churches, and finding out about our bishop. Read Bible stories together or encourage older children to read a child's Bible.

Early Years	DESERT TO GARDEN - Looking forward to Easter
Year 1	DESERT TO GARDEN – Lent as a time for preparing for Easter
Year 2	DESERT TO GARDEN – Holy Week and forgiveness
Year 3	DESERT TO GARDEN – Eucharist at the Last Supper
Year 4	GIVING & RECEIVING - Living in communion
Year 5	MEMORIAL SACRIFICE - Eucharist as the living memorial of Christ's sacrifice
Year 6	UNITY - Eucharist enabling people to live in communion
