Reception Intake Information

Friday July 10th

Dear parents and carers,

We are very much looking forward to meeting with you and your child in September. As you will already be aware, the children will begin their transition taster sessions for school the week beginning 7th September 2020.

Government guidelines do not allow large gatherings of parents and teachers so we will not be able to meet together on Monday 7th as we had hoped. We are therefore going to organise nine smaller meetings with a maximum of six people attending. These meetings will be held on Monday 7th, Tuesday 8th and Wednesday 9th of September at 4.30pm, 5.15pm and 6.00pm. Each meeting will last 30 minutes. This will allow cleaning of chairs between each group of parents. We can only invite one parent from each family to attend. Four parents along with myself and Mr Bates will form the group of six. I will inform you as to which meeting to attend.

During the week beginning 7th September, your child is invited to attend school for three taster sessions. These sessions will be an hour and a half either in the morning or in the afternoon. They will take place on Tuesday 8th, Wednesday 9th and Friday 11th of September. The morning session will begin at 9.30am and last until 11.00am with the afternoon session beginning at 1.30pm and ending at 3.00pm. We would like you to phone the school office and confirm with Mrs Penlington the three sessions you would like to book. We are going to limit the number of children to 16 in each session and we will operate a first come/first served basis. When you bring your child to school, you will be welcomed into the classroom by the teachers. The main footpath gate near the zebra crossing will be opened for you.

On Friday 11th September, at the end of their last taster session, the children will receive an information pack explaining who their class teacher will be and who their key worker will be. You will also receive a 'Starting School' letter in the pack detailing the staggered start for the children for the following week beginning 14th September. The staggered start will be from Monday 14th September to Wednesday 16th of September with all of the children in school full time from Thursday 17th September.
