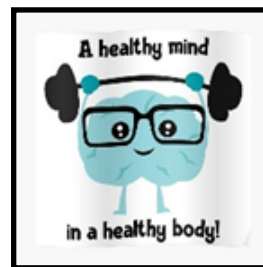

**Communication & Language**

We will begin to develop our Communication skills, using longer sentences and engaging in conversations.

We will begin to learn how to listen and respond appropriately

We will listen to a variety of stories and begin remembering key parts.

We will begin to develop our vocabulary

We will start to understand questions and two-part instructions.

**Physical Development**

**Gymnastics:**

We will focus on special awareness in Gymnastics

We will learn to move to different types of music

We will develop our movements. i.e jumping etc

**Fine Motor:**

We will strengthen our fine motor skills through activities.

We will learn how to use a range of small tools, including scissors, paintbrushes and cutlery

**Personal, Social and Emotional Development**

We will start to develop friendships, playing co-operatively, and displaying individual interests..

We will begin to develop sharing skills when using resources.

We will explore our different emotions and feelings.

We will develop our 'Golden Rules' for Nursery so that we are all happy in our Nursery life.

We will compare groups of objects using the language, more then, fewer and same.

We will explore and build with shapes.

We will explore repeating patterns.

We will hear and say number names and begin to order them

We will learn to subitise : 1,2,3

We will use our senses in hands on exploration of Autumn natural materials.

We will be developing our drawing skills by drawing ourselves and our families.

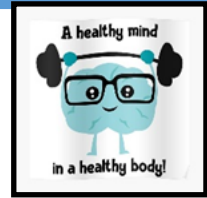
In Music, we will be exploring sound and we will be experimenting with our voices and bodies to make different sounds.

Emotions: happy, sad, scared etc

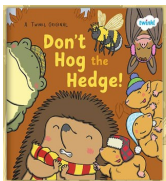
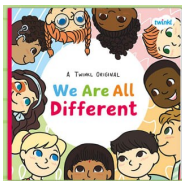
Autumn;
