'We are Explorers'

"Loving God In All We Do."

The 'We are Explorers' theme is about ...

Winter, The Arctic, Bears, Chinese New Year, Celebrations

Communication & Language

We will learn and use new vocabulary related to the topic.

*We will be able to ask questions to find out more and to check understanding.

*We will develop our sentences further by articulating ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences and be able to escribe events in some detail.

*We will learn to retell stories, some as exact repetition and some in our own words.

*We will listen carefully to rhymes and songs, paying attention to how they sound.

*Listen to and talk about selected non-fiction to develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge and vocabulary.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*We will see ourselves as valuable individuals.

*We will express our feelings and consider the feelings of others.

*We will show resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge.

*We will identify and learn to moderate our own feelings socially and emotionally and think about the perspectives of others.

*We will continue to manage our own needs.

Understanding the World

* We will understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around and use our senses.

*We will compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past e.g. Ernest Shackleton.

*We will start to identify some similarities and differences between things in the past and now.

We will explore a simple map and identify that there are different countries in the world and talk about the similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries.

- We will recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways e.g. Chinese New Year.

Physical Development

In P.E. this half term, we will be exploring Dance .

*We will be linking actions and sequences of movement.

- * We will develop overall body-strength, balance, co-ordination and agility.
- *We will combine different movements with ease and fluency.

*We will progress towards a more fluent style of moving, with developing control and grace.

*We will continue our development of holding and using tools correctly and safely e.g. pencils and scissors.

<u>Maths</u>

*We will be counting and comparing numbers and quantities to 10 in different contexts, including the composition of each number.

*We will be exploring addition to 10, including recapping one more and less.

*We will subitise up to 5.

*We will be learning to automatically recall number bonds for numbers 0-5 and some to 10.

*We will compare Length, Height, Distance and Weight.

Expressive Arts & Design

In Art ,we will be exploring colour mixing and using a variety of artistic effects to create Winter Art and Bear Art.

-We will explore different materials freely, to develop ideas about how to use them and what to make.

-We will join different materials and explore different textures to create landmarks and artefacts around the world.

In Music, we will explore a unit based on traditional children's tales and songs, and learn that music and instruments can be used to convey moods or represent characters.

We will learn to understand that a piece of music can tell a story with sounds and sound like a particular character.





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Literacy

Core Texts:

Lost and Found: Links to winter topic and exploring friendships

We're Going on a Bear Hunt: Links to our Winter topic and looking at the seasons. Children enjoy acting out the story orally.

Goldilocks and the Three Bears: Links to our bear topic, and offers opportunities for making porridge and writing instructions

Nursery Rhymes:

I'm a little penguin black and white: Linking to the topic of Winter I'm a little Snowman: Linking to the topic of Winter Five Little Snowmen: Linking to the topic of Winter Sing a song of Winter: Linking to the topic of Winter Twinkle Twinkle Little Star: Linking to the Nativity and the importance of the star When Goldilocks Went to the House of the Bears: Linking to Traditional tale Hibernation, time for hibernation: Linking to the topic of Winter Phonics

We will be recapping over phase 2 sounds and blending and segmenting them and introducing phase 3 sounds.

Key Vocabulary

Senses- humans perceive the world so that we may make decisions about what is happening and what is needed in a situation (sight, hear, touch, taste, smell)

Weather is a specific event—like a rainstorm or hot day—that happens over a few hours, days or weeks.

Climate is the average weather conditions in a place over 30 years or more.

Journey/travel – a trip from one place to another.

A material is any substance that has a name. For example: chalk, paper, wood, iron, air, water, clay, plastic, rubber, stone, leather, wax. Everything is made up of materials. When we want to make something we need to choose the best material for the job.

Man-made/natural

Primary Colour- Red, yellow, and blue. All of the other colours can be made from these three.

Lyrics – The words to a song.

Verse - a series of lyrics that tell the main story of the song and keep the action or thoughts moving forward.

Beat - The heartbeat of the music.

Pulse - steady beat like a ticking clock or your heartbeat.

Composer- A person who creates or write an original (new) piece of music.
