#### 'Galilee to Jerusalem'

*"Loving God In All We Do."*



#### The 'Galilee to Jerusalem' topic is about ...

During this topic, the children will be introduced to the miracles of Jesus and how they expressed his love for all people. This half term we will be looking at significant people from history Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole and how they have changed our world for the good. This will link into our English Unit of George's Marvellous medicine and Kitchen Disco, as we focus on staying safe and staying healthy.

#### Prior learning

To know that you should tell a trusted adult if you feel unsafe or worried online.

Retell some events from beyond their living memory which are significant nationally or globally.

To build on music knowledge from Year 1.

In R.E we have learnt the symbol of water, the arrival of Jesus and his cousin John the Baptist who had an important prophecy to fulfil.

#### Our current learning

- To understand the difference between online and offline.
- To look at significant people from history and to understand how they have made changes over the years.
- To look at the composes of a piece of music and
- recognise pitch, tempo and dynamics.
- Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive .

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#### **RE**

During this branch the children will build on their learning in Creation and Covenant, where they learnt the catholic symbolism for water as they learn about the first reconciliation of Baptism. They will then learn how John became John the Baptist as he fulfilled his prophecy from God as he baptised Jesus.

#### **Wider curriculum learning**

The **Maths** units that we will be covering are money followed by multiplication and division.

The focus for **Science** is Living things and their habitats where the children will be sorting and classifying things according to whether they are living, dead or were never alive, and recording their findings using charts. They will describe how they decided where to place things by exploring 'big questions.'

The **Computing** unit is Online Safety, we will be looking at how to keep safe online and who to tell if we are feel something is not right.

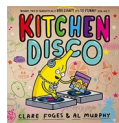
