#### <u>RE</u>

During this branch the children will build on their learning in Creation and Covenant, where they learnt the catholic symbolism for water as they learn about the first reconciliation of Baptism. They will then learn how John became John the Baptist as he fulfilled his prophecy from God as he baptised Jesus.

### Wider curriculum learning

The **Maths** units that we will be covering are money followed by multiplication and division.

The focus for **Science** is Living things and their habitats where the children will be sorting and classifying things according to whether they are living, dead or were never alive, and recording their findings using charts. They will describe how they decided where to place things by exploring big questions.'

The **Computing** unit is Online Safety, we will be looking at how to keep safe online and who to tell if we are feel something is not right.
