

The 'Animal Kingdom' topic is about ...

The children will be learning about habitats through our English and Science topics. The topic will focus on many different animals and their habitats. There will be opportunities for extensive research on a chosen animal and creation of an information booklet using facts and knowledge learnt.

What we already know...

- All animals have a special part in the animal kingdom.
- Different animals eat different foods.
- There are predators and prey.
- Lions are the king of the animal kingdom.
- Lions have a pride which consists of up to 15 lions.
- There is lots of plastic in our oceans.

By the end of the topic we will know:

How to recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.

Explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.

Recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

How to use and make identification keys for plants and animals

Suggest their own ideas on a concept and compare these with what they observe / find out.
