Computing

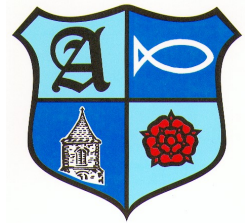
Branching databases, discrete data, open ended questions, closed questions, graphs, venn diagrams.



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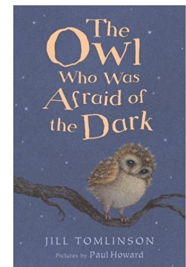


Wider curriculum learning
