'We Are Creative!'

"Loving God In All We Do"



The 'We Are Creative' topic is about ...

In Design and Technology, the children will research ideas, plan, create and evaluate a moving vehicle. They will develop cutting and fixing skills and explore different ways to create a moving wheel using an axle.

For Music, they will appraise different types of music and evaluate how they are similar and how they are different. They will explore different ways of keeping to the pulse using their voice, bodies and musical instruments.

What we already know:

We asked the children what they already knew about "being creative!" They said:

- You use different materials to design, create and make new things. You can use paper, scissors, glues, brushes, glitter and pom poms!
- We use our imagination.
- We can be creative through drawing, painting, music and dancing.
- We have been learning about new artists like Van Gogh.

By the end of the topic we will know how to:

- explore the sounds of our voices and various musical instruments
- explore different types of moving vehicles and talk about the way they move
- create a moving vehicle using axles, wheels and a chassis

Fraction, part, equivalent, numerator, denominator, equal, multiply, sharing, doubling, lots of groups of, array.



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
Wider curriculum learning
