Dear parents,

Building works to the main school entrance

The works to the new front entrance are underway with minimal disruption to routines. We have had to make a few internal changes to systems which are communicated as follows:

Dinnertime phone call to the office - The office is now located in the KS1 building in the staffroom. The staffroom is a shared space between 12.00noon and 1.00pm. During this hour, phone calls will automatically go through to the answer machine with office staff listening to the messages. If it is essential to return the call during dinnertime, office staff will phone from the business manager's office to ensure privacy.

Children arriving late to school – Parents must walk their child to the main office and sign them in. Staff will then be called to walk children to the correct classrooms. All children should be in school prior to 8.55am to avoid this additional and unnecessary task.

Building materials delivered to school – It is very difficult to arrange timeframes for deliveries on site. Please can all adults pay particular attention to our children's safety if building materials are being delivered at the beginning or end of the school day. Parents using breakfast and after school clubs will need to be extra careful when driving within the school grounds during the building works.

Teaching arrangements for the academic year 2022/2023

We have a few changes to our staffing structure for the next academic year with Mrs Walker leaving and Mrs Seddon reducing her working week to part-time. We have recruited two new teachers to our school. Miss Whiteside has been appointed as the Early Years Foundations Stage Lead and will also teach in the Reception classroom. Mrs Elwill has been appointed as a teacher and will teach in Year 4. We welcome our new teachers to St Anne's knowing they will be made to feel very happy as they settle into school life.
