A CHALLENGING CHANGE

As the children now move to Key Stage 2 we want to encourage the children to be more independent and encourage that children take more responsibility for themselves.

READING

- Teacher led Guided Reading once a week, using unseen fiction and non-fiction texts .
- Whilst other children are being heard read other activities will be being completed which are based around the class text.
- Children who finished Year 2 on white or above reading stage they are to choose their own books for school & home.
- There is no day for changing books.

HOMework

- The children will either receive one piece of English and Maths homework every Friday. (Occasionally it will be linked to another area of the curriculum.)
- The homework will be sent via Class Charts. Nothing needs to be sent into school but via the class chart system and the teachers will mark it on there. If there is a need for it to be printed that can be done in school.
- These pieces of homework are due back by the latest the following Wednesday.
- Spellings will be given out on Friday to be returned on Friday, for a test but will be taught during spelling lessons during the week.



DAYS TO REMEMBER

- Reading books can be changed any day.
- PE day is every Thursday.
- Homework to 'go live' on a Friday and completed by the following Wednesday unless stated.
- Spellings to be given out on a Friday and tested the following Friday.
