#### **Bug Club Phonics**

- New Phonics Scheme
- Following the government directives for a fully systematic synthetic phonics scheme.
- Daily lessons reading, writing, spelling and handwriting.
- Reading books are linked to the weekly sound.



#### **Home Reading**

- Home reading is time to practise
- The books are linked to the Bug Club Phonics Scheme
- Two books will be sent home each week
- We will set the books online each Friday
- 'Reading Challenge'



# Guided Reading at St Anne's School



- Guided Reading is for teaching reading
- Books will initially be linked to the Phonics scheme
- Children will read once a week with the teacher
- Focus objective each week
- A group reading session reading and discussion time.
- Weekly group activities –


comprehension, pre-read task, and reading response task.

## **Guided Reading**

- The guided reading books are fiction, non-fiction and plays.
- The books are levelled so they give the children challenge, but they still need to be able to read them independently.



## **Handwriting**




#### We want our children to:

- take pride in the presentation of their work.
- develop a fluent, comfortable, legible handwriting style.
- form ascenders and descenders correctly.
- form and use the four basic cursive handwriting joins.
- There will be 1 weekly handwriting session, but constant modelling throughout the week.

#### <u>Maths</u>

- A challenging curriculum through White Rose Maths.
- Confidence with numbers to at least 100.
- Times tables (2, 5, 10) TT Rockstars
- Written and mental strategies for +,  $\div$ , -, x calculations and when to apply them in *problem solving* and *reasoning*.
- Practical activities
- 4 a day





The children are given their reading, spelling and Homework on Friday:

- Reading (2 books per week using the online Bug Club scheme)
- Weekly English/ Maths tasks (set on Class Charts)
- Spellings (linked to Phonics)
- Homework is submitted by Thursday.
- Spelling quiz is on Friday, please return books on Monday.
