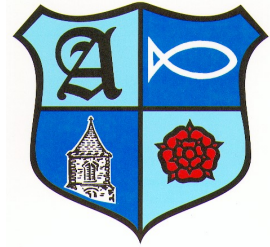

The 'Galilee to Jerusalem' topic is about ...

How Jesus is the Son of God, revealed through moments like Simeon and Anna recognising his divinity. St. Luke's Gospel highlights Jesus' care for the marginalised, showing his compassion, inclusivity, and love for those on the edges of society, including women, shepherds, and children.

In this exciting branch of learning, pupils will discover the Christian belief in Jesus as the Son of God. They will explore how characters like Simeon and Anna recognised the extraordinary nature of the baby Jesus in the bustling temple. Through engaging stories from St Luke's gospel, students will learn how Jesus showed love and kindness, especially to those on society's edges, like the poor and vulnerable. With an understanding of the Bible as the sacred text, learners will begin to appreciate Jesus' mission and journey alongside St Luke, fostering compassion and connection with others.

Wider curriculum learning

The **Maths** units that we will be covering are Place Value within 20 and Addition and Subtraction within 20 and measuring length and height.

The focus for **Science** is Materials. The children will explore and group a range of materials according to their properties.

In **Art** we shall learn about the techniques used by the artist Lowry and use these to create a final piece.

Our **History** learning will be centred around "The Great Fire of London" which is taught through our

English topic on Information books. The children will learn about and sequence the events of the fire.

In **PSHE** this half term we will focus on Mental Health, Special People, communities and Managing Hurtful behaviour.
