The 'Prophecy and Promise topic is about ...

Preparation for the arrival of Jesus. This half term the children will be learning about the history and significance our of school church St Anne's and how the way it has served our community has changed over the years. The children will then be using their artistic skills to sketch the entrance of our church in two different styles (realism and abstract). The children will then write a non-chronological report about Ormskirk, which will include our wonderful St Anne's Church. Later on in the term the children will be using their scientific knowledge about materials to build a stable which is strong, and stiff structure.

Prior learning

We can:

- recognise the distinction between past and present.
- order and sequence some familiar events and objects.
- identify some similarities and differences between ways of life at different times.
- know use 'a long time ago' and 'before' to describe passing of time
- Name tools and materials that we want to use and explain why
- Use recycled materials to mock up our designs
- Identify different technology at home and in school and recognise its purpose

Our current learning

- Recognise that their own lives are similar and / or different from the lives of people in the past.
- Develop awareness of significant historical events, people and places in their own locality
- Ask and answer simple questions about the past through observing and handling a range of sources.
- Use a range of materials to make a strong, stable and stiff structure

Wider curriculum learning
