## Year 2 Medium Term Plan 'We are Creative'



### RE

#### Rules

- *Talk* about how the rules in school and at home can help us..
- *Retell how* Jesus teaches his disciples about forgiving.
- *Describe* the Sacrament of Reconciliation

### English

#### Letters

This half term the children will read 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Oliver Jeffers and write their own letters by including;

- The use of, exclamation marks.
- Use subordination for time and reasoning using when, before and after
- Effective and progressive verbs.

### Maths

#### Addition

- Add a two-digit number to another two-digit number including crossing a tens boundary

#### Subtraction

- Subtract a one-digit number from a two-digit number including crossing a tens boundary

#### Place Value

- Describe the rule in a number sequence counting on and back in fives, tens or twos from any number

### Driver Subject Science—Materials

This half term the children will be exploring different materials and will be learning:

- To identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, water, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.
- Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching (applying a force).
- Some materials can be found naturally; others have to be made.

### Scientific Enquiry

- Recognise if results matched predictions and say if results were what they expected).
- Use their recordings to talk about and describe what has happened.
- Use simple scientific language to talk about and record what they have noticed.
- Carry out simple comparative tests as part of a group, following a method with some independence.
- Make a simple prediction about what might happen and try to give a vague reason
- Name / identify common examples of different materials
- Compare and contrast different materials.

### Information Technology

#### Presenting Ideas

This term the children will look at different ways of presenting by:

- Explore how a story can be presented in different ways
- Make a quiz about a story
- Making a fact file on a non-fiction topic

### RSE/ PSHE

'We meet God's Love in our community'

The children will explore:

- about what rules are, why they are needed, and why different rules are needed for different situations

### Design Technology

#### Building a Structure

This half term the children will make a house for the crayons from the story 'The Day The Crayons Quit'. The children will use their knowledge of materials and

- build structures, exploring how they can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable

### PE

#### Gymnastics

This half term the children will be:

- Create and link simple combinations of 3 or 4 actions in ways that suit the physical activity.
- Describe what they have done or seen others doing
- Comment on a skill or combination of skills and say how it could be improved.

### Art & Design

The children will explore 'Seaside collage' by Serena Hall. They will then:

- Recognise the styles of a Serena Hall, and use this to inform their own work.
- Confidently use design techniques to explore the use texture, and colour to replicate Serena Hall's 'Seaside Collage'.

### Music

#### Friendship Song

This half term the children will:

- Listen and appraise different songs about friendship
- Build on their knowledge to find the pulse and rhythm of a song
- Improvise perform a song using the same pulse or rhythm
