The 'We are Creative' theme is about ...

...being creative in all our subjects. During this half term the children will create their own code during our Computing unit. In addition to this, the children will be exploring how different illustrators demonstrate their own creativity by selecting different media, colours and tools. Building on this, the children will become illustrators and use Quentin Blake and Drew Daywalt to influence their own personal style as they personify a piece of stationary in their own style.

Wider curriculum learning

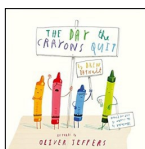
Our driver subject this half term is **Art** and we will be comparing the talented illustrators Drew Daywalt and Quentin Blake, focusing on each artists style, choice of media and use of colour.

This half term, in **RE** we will be learning about the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The children will be recognising and describing how to say sorry and ask for forgiveness.

In **Maths** we will be continuing our topic on time before learning about position and direction. Then we will finish our school year learning about representing data using graphs and charts.

Our **Design Technology** learning will be centred around designing, making and evaluating a strong, stiff and stable house for the crayons (from 'The Day the Crayons Quit' story) to live together. For this the children will draw upon their scientific knowledge of everyday materials and their properties, that they learnt during 'Our World' Autumn term 2.

We are going to read a range of texts from:



This half term the children will be reading the humorous and immensely enjoyable book 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Drew Daywalt, illustrated by Oliver Jeffers, which is based on a series of letters. They will be writing their own letters that will include: the use of exclamation marks, the use subordination for time and reasoning (using when, before and after) and the use of effective verbs.
