The 'We are Creative' theme is about ...

Exploring art and artists through the ages.

Developing knowledge and understanding of artistic techniques and using them in our own creative work.

Planning our own compositions, creating them in a variety of media and evaluating outcomes.

Frida Kahlo's focus on flowers in her artwork also links nicely with our flowering plants Science topic.

What we already know...

- What contrasting colours are.
- That plants need sunshine and water to live.
- Too much litter in the oceans is dangerous for the animals
- We should recycle more to help our grandchildren.
- Beautiful flowers appear in the season of Summer.

By the end of the theme we will know ...

- About a major artists from history and be able to identify her work based on what we have learnt about her.
- About artistic techniques including shading and printing.
- How and when to use different media in art.
- About the life cycle of flowering plants.


In **RE** we are learning how choices have consequences and about asking for forgiveness as part of our Reconciliation Topic.
