Year 3 Curriculum Information

'We are Creative'

"Loving God In All We Do."



The 'We are creative' topic is about ...

During this theme, the children will consider their personal experiences drawing on learning about other cultures, communities and traditions. In R.E. they will make connections between some Islamic religious laws, beliefs, worship, and life e.g., belief in one God, the Creator, the significance of Muhammed and the importance of the will of God.

In Art they will research the artist Matisse and understand the historical and cultural development of his art forms. They will learn how to mix secondary colours and compare contrasting colours. They will research the collages of Matisse and create a collage using cut outs with vibrant colours. In Geography, they will find out about the physical and human features of Nice in France and make comparisons with Ormskirk.

Prior learning

Art: The children have previously in Year 2 explored how different illustrators demonstrate their own creativity by selecting different media, colours and tools. Building on this, the children then became illustrators and used Quentin Blake and Drew Daywalt as an inspiration.

Geography: The children have used globes and atlases to identify different continents and oceans and compared human and physical features of the UK and Australia.

By the end of the theme we will know ...

About the life and times of Matisse .

How to mix paints – create colour wheel – look at primary, secondary, warm, cold and contrasting colours.

How to create a still-life painting, using water colours

How to create cut-outs with vibrant colours.

How to locate the UK and France using globes, maps and atlases.

How to describe and compare key aspects of the human and physical geography of the area of Nice and Ormskirk.

RE

During this topic, we cover the teaching of other religions and worldviews. The children will make links between Exodus (12:1-8, 15-20, 13:3) and the account of the Last Supper. They will learn to describe how Jewish people celebrate the Passover in Britain today making links with the Exodus account. They will learn about some Islamic religious laws, beliefs, worship, and life—the belief in one God, the Creator, the significance of Muhammed, importance of the will of God.

Wider curriculum learning

In Science, the children will be learning about plants and the functions of different parts of flowering plants. They will also explore the stages of the life cycle of flowering plants.

In French, they will build sentences to describe where something lives or does not live.

In PSHE, they will think about their aspirations and recognise positive things about themselves and their achievements. They will learn about the importance of setting goals to help achieve personal outcomes.

In Music, they will be introduced to traditional Indian music and instruments and create a piece of music using a drone, rag and tal.
