'Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds'

"Loving God In All We Do."



The 'Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds' topic is about ...

The children will learn to identify the different types of teeth and their functions. They will learn the composition of a tooth, how to look after their teeth and the importance of oral hygiene.

The children will also be learning about the journey that our food takes through the digestive system, the different organs and their functions and the importance of diet and nutrition.

Prior learning

Science—Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.

Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Our current learning

In English, the children are reading a novel with a theme called The Astounding Broccoli Boy. The children will be working towards writing their own version of a chapter in the style of the author.

In Maths, the children are focusing on understanding Place Value this includes partitioning in different ways, rounding numbers to nearest 10, 100 and 1000 and ordering and comparing 4 digit numbers.

During the GPS sessions, the children are focusing on nouns and adjectives leading on to using noun phrases.

Organs, liver, stomach, small intestine, large intestine, oesopha-



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
RE People

Wider curriculum learning

- In Computing, the topic is Data Handling. The children will be searching the web efficiently to find temperatures of different cities and record this accurately. They will design a weather station and search and record weather forecast in a spreadsheet.
- During the DT sessions, the children will learn about seasonality and they will plan a healthy meal using seasonal vegetables. The process of planning, making and evaluating will be completed over a few weeks.
- In French, the children will learn all about transport and countries and days of the week and months of the year.
