The 'Prophecy and Promise topic is about ...

Stories with fantasy settings. Our focus text for this half term will be 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone'. The children will explore and analyse this text in detail before using it as inspiration to write their own chapters. Towards the end of the term, the children will explore films and play scripts. They will use the Harry Potter text alongside the film to create their own play scripts.

In DT, the children will continue their Hogwarts Castle project. The children will create a circuit to light up their castle which is linked to our second Science topic.
