Myths

The children will create an alternative Ancient Greece myth that include features of a Greek myth e.g. Gods/Goddesses, mythical creatures. They will focus on writing complex sentences beginning with a simile, build cohesion throughout paragraphs, plus include direct speech correctly.

Researching in order to create a biography, plus write their own autobiography.

Outdoor development

Year 5 will be developing the Peace Garden:

Developing the story of the dragonfly through mosaics, sculptures through the use of different materials, painting and links to our focus artists.

Science

States of Matter - Materials: Reversible and irreversible changes.

- The children will explore materials, discovering that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and describe how to recover a substance from a solution.
- Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.

Scientific Enquiry

The children will focus on Pattern seeking, plus identifying and classifying materials.

The children will be asked questions to encourage them to explore their knowledge and identify ways to discover answers to these questions.
