### Year 6 Curriculum Information

#### 'We are Creative'

*"Loving God In All We Do."*



#### The 'We are Creative' topic is about ...

In Art the children will use the seaside and our local environment as inspiration for their own work. Children will experiment with a range of print media to create different effects, gathering and developing their ideas into two final prints which will be displayed on their very own t-shirts.

In English children will read the story Wonder, by R.J. Palacio and explore issues of identity, kindness and celebrate uniqueness. Pupils will complete a variety of writing opportunities such as diary entries, discursive essays and poetry. They will also study and perform poems on the theme of the sea, using the poem Sea Fever by Jason Masefield as inspiration for their own poetry writing.

#### Prior Learning

- Experiment with pieces of fabric to show the effects of different ideas and techniques to alter its appearance.
- Develop knotting, threading, binding and dyeing techniques.
- Make a raised fabric surface using folding and scrunching techniques.
- Decorating the raised surface with paints and dyes.
- Become proficient in selecting materials and processes and organise and combine these in their work.

#### Our Current Learning

- How to use screen printing techniques independently and accurately.
- Draw directly onto fabric with correct amount of pressure.
- Add glue onto areas of print that ink will not pass through.
- Use the squeegee to transfer ink across fabric evenly.
- Select and develop linear designs into relief print blocks.
- Transfer designs onto different scales and surfaces.

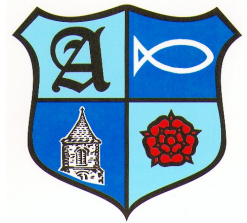

**RE**

In RE we will be explaining what happens when people become sick and need care, during our topic of 'Healing'. Children will also look at the wider world and aim to show understanding of how our Catholic faith can help us to work together with communities worldwide. This will form part of our topic 'Common Good', where pupils will also look at the work of CAFOD and make links to their own actions.

**Wider curriculum learning**

In **Maths** pupils will continue to consolidate their knowledge and skills, applying them to real life scenarios, e.g. building and running a theme park.

In **Computing** pupils will be using their website skills to create a new design based on digital citizenship.

In **French** pupils will use existing knowledge of vocabulary and phrases to create new sentences to be used in a tourism brochure.

In **PE** pupils will be practising their tennis skills as well as dance.

Throughout the term children will be thinking about the transition to high school and in **PSHE** lessons will learn about the new opportunities and responsibilities that increasing independence may bring. Pupils will explore problem-solving strategies for dealing with emotions, challenges and change, including the tran-
