

READING

- Teacher led Guided Reading once a week, using unseen fiction and non-fiction texts.
- Whilst other children are being heard read other activities will be being completed which are based around the class text.
- Children who finished Year 2 on white or above reading stage they are to choose their own books for school & home.
- There is no day for changing books.

Homework.

- The children will either receive one piece of English and Maths homework every Friday. (Occasionally it will be linked to another area of the curriculum.)
- These pieces of homework are due back by the latest the following Wednesday.
- Maths will be either in their homework book or online using MyMaths

Spellings will be given out on Friday to be returned on Friday, for a test but will taught during spelling lessons during the week.
