

The 'We Are Explorers' topic is about ...

During this topic the children will be learning about Earth, Space and the Solar System.

We will have a visit from a potable planetarium company called, 'Wonder Dome' to broaden our knowledge of space and space exploration.

What we already know...

Some of the children know most of the names of the planets in the solar system. They are also aware that Ceres and Pluto are known as dwarf planets.

They know the sun is 5600° Celsius, and that when stars become too hot they explode.

By the end of the topic we will know (NC)

All about Earth, the planets and our solar system. Also we will know about space travel and astronauts.

By the end of the topic we will be able to (skills progression)

Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object. Also, articulate and explain findings from their research using scientific knowledge, vocab and understanding.

Science

Space, Solar System, Universe, Galaxies, Milky Way, Asteroids, Meteors, Stars, Constellations.

Music

Film Music: composers, dynamics, tempo, pitch, genre, instruments, vocals, suitability.

Art & Design

Sketch, label, model, scale, materials.

Passwords, online safety, security, acceptable / un-acceptable behaviour, report concerns, cyber bullying, appropriate content.
