Whole School Break time Toast/Fruit Toast and Milk

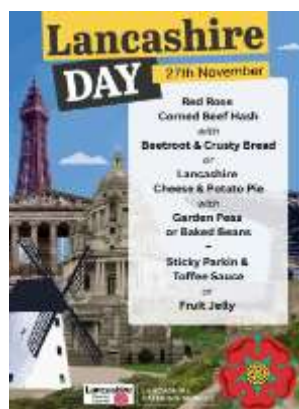

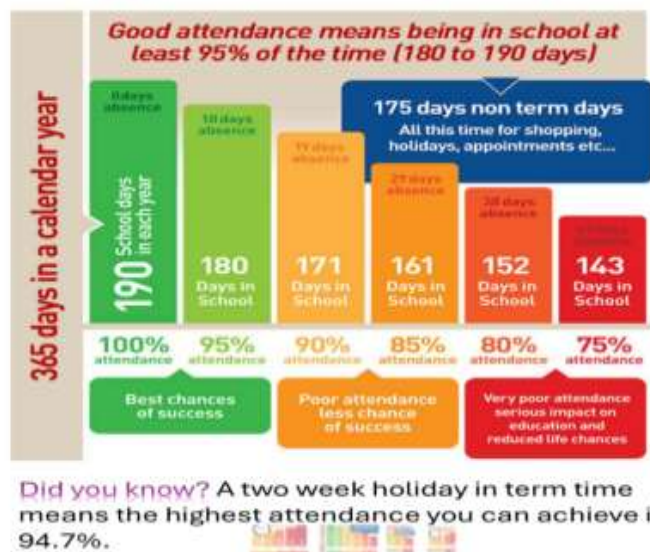
