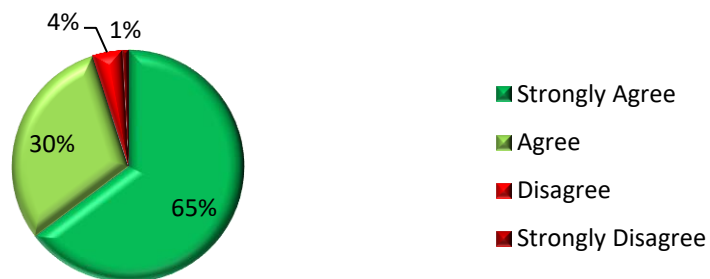

Results based on 118 returns from parents

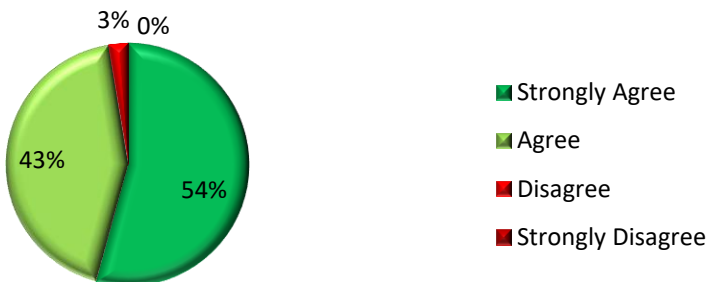
1. My child is happy at this school



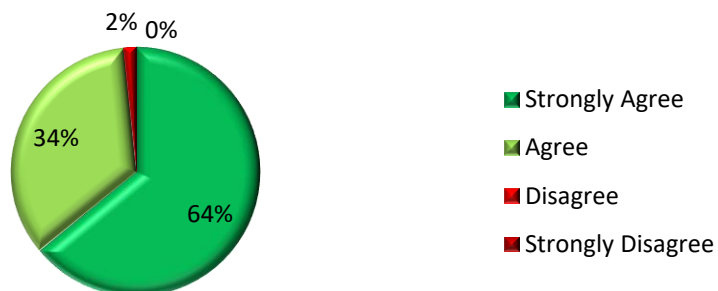

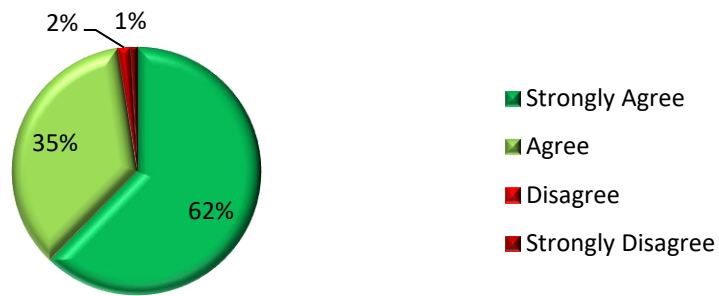

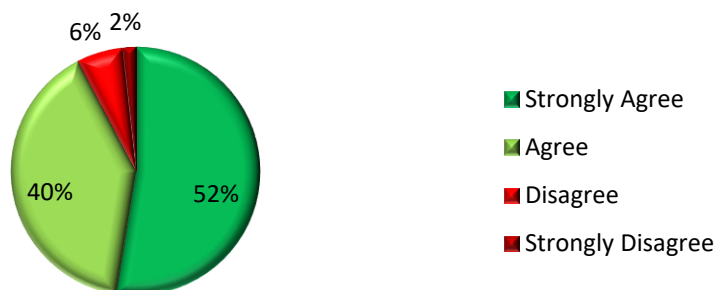

- School homework for Infants every week is too much. I am a working mum and my child has mosque as well and my child finds it hard to do both. I disagree with homework in holidays as a young child every week she has 4 sheets and holidays projects to make and reminders from teachers are very annoying. Homework should be limited from time to time as currently asked for maths, spelling, with 2 books to read is very too much
- I would like my child to get more homework to what he has done in class
- School parents parking – entrance should be on Charlotte Street. There is a gate there already. Current entrance is too dangerous
- Parking outside the school is horrendous at times. It is dangerous for the children crossing with drivers reversing/speeding etc
- Not sure what can be done but many parents park selfishly
