What activities would they like to see on the playground at break/dinner times?

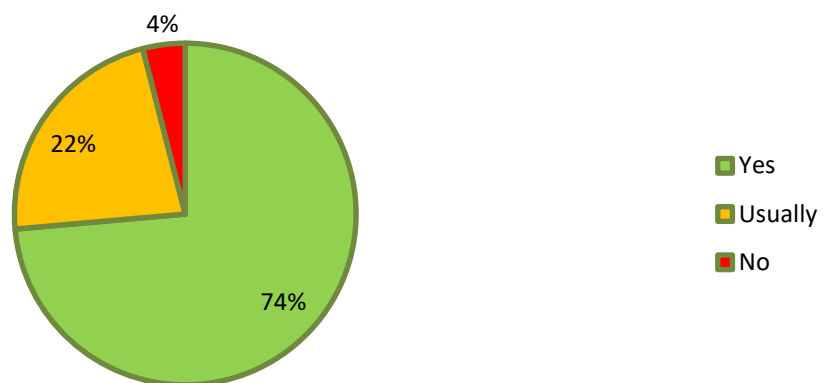
- More balls to play football

What else would you like to improve about the school?

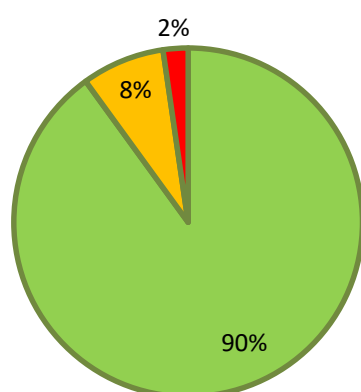
- More toys like the giraffe game, more superhero dolls, truck crane, fidget spinners, vehicles, a real princess castle

What do you like about the school?

Year 3: Art, parties, maths, science, breaktime/lunch, PE, topics, Computing, English, trips, Golden Time, making new friends

Year 3/4: Children are friendly, work is fun and not too hard, lots of people to help me, like learning outdoors, like next steps, like teachers helping to improve work, like having time off work, like the competitions, like grammar, like fun MADD days

Year 4/5: Good education, sport tournaments, dinnertime, girls group, clubs

Year 5/6: learn fun things, party days, trips, encouragement, teachers are kind, fun clubs, sports events/days, fairs, different things to do, nice teachers

Year 6: Kind and helpful teacher and children, you get to meet new children when you change class, teachers are fair

What clubs do they like?

Year 3: Homework, choir, henna, footballs

Year 3/4: Sports – especially football

Year 4/5: Football, choir, boys/girls' groups, homework, multi-sports

Year 5/6: choir, piano, football, sports

Year 6: football, multi-sport, choir, ukulele, homework club, piano, guitar

What clubs would you like to be able to do?

Year 3: Cookery, art, maths, skipping, Computing, cricket, sewing, gardening, basketball

Year 3/4: Dodge ball, henna, movie, tennis, cricket, art, reading, computer, basketball, rounders, more lunchtime clubs because of mosque

Year 4/5: cricket, rounders, dancing, athletics, sports, art and craft, baking, henna

Year 5/6: swimming, netball, biking, gymnastics

Year 6: cooking club, boxing, athletics, swimming, science, arts and crafts, gaming club, art, table tennis, origami, archery

What activities would they like to see on the playground at break/dinner times?

Year 3: Football, archery, tennis, cricket, golf, trampolining, outdoor painting (stones), chill out zone, obstacle course

Year 3/4: Bigger trip trail, stage (like infants), slide/swings, reading in new reading area

Year 4/5: basketball, elastics, racing, tennis, netball

Year 5/6: javelin, hut to be a reading/drawing area, reading area, library book club

Year 6: acting/drama, netball, dodgeball, cycling, selling/enterprise, trampoline, tuck shop

What else would you like to improve about school?

Year 3: Slide/ swings on playground, buy fruit from school, class toilets, bigger classrooms, air conditioning in the classrooms, comfier chairs

Year 3/4: Instant rewards for good work, longer swimming lessons, choosing time, collect money at Christmas to buy presents like at Mother/Father's day, longer Golden Time (and go on Infant yard/dodgeball in hall), Eid presents, wet playtime each class go into the hall, more laptops, lego in classrooms

Year 4/5: the hut being a quiet area not playground, make the bike hut more secure (locks and doors), more after school booster classes not only year 6, more activities on playground like trim trail

Year 5/6: paint the hut, upgrade the trim trail (slide, swings, climbing frame, trampoline), rock climbing wall, slip and slide mats, zip line

Year 6: better kits, more non-uniform days, better PE equipment, free breakfast club, free dinners, better technology, time to study in the library, bring phone to school, more high school visits, own time, put TV in hut, go home at lunch time
