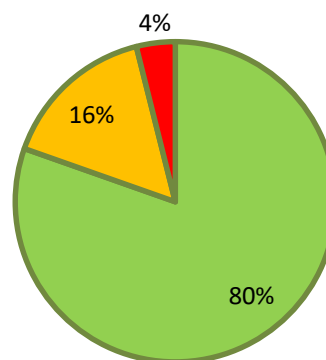
Overall – selected joint questions

What do like about the school?

Blossom: to go swimming, play football, plant trees, play Roblox, play more, nothing.

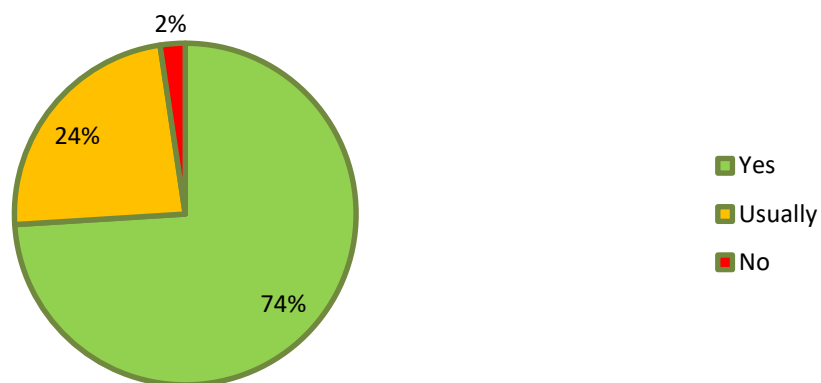
Willow: more computers in the classroom, more playtime.

Sycamore: more trips, horse riding, tuck shop, mini bus, fossils, cinema, swimming pool, more playtime.

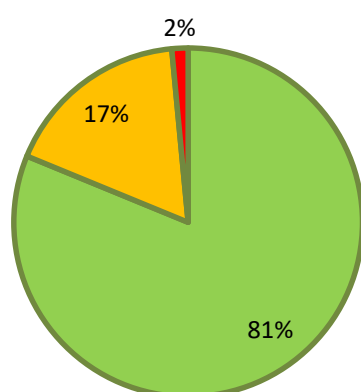

What do you like about the school?

Year 3: love learning, English, PE, teachers are kind and helpful, Maths, PE lessons, playing with friends, art lessons, lunchtime (trying different foods), free food donations, making new friends, Golden Time, Geography, science.

Year 3/4: Sports Day, science experiments, singing practice, trim trail, playing with friends, computer room, playing out, PE, parties, football pitch, basketball nets.

Year 4/5: PE, Playtime, different things/subjects in class, art, PSHE, Computing, Golden Time, Maths, Dodgeball, English, Science, the library, Boys Club, the teachers, lunchtime bands, music, swimming.

Year 5/6: Reward time and breaks, fun lessons, German, swimming, boosters to help us get better, interesting lessons to learn new things, exciting experiments, science and art are really fun, teachers are nice, time to work and chatter, when work is hard you get help from friends.

Year 3/4: more football pitches, more equipment for the playground (hula hoops, another trim trail), a garden where you can sit at break and do gardening, everyone wearing the same uniform so we look good, everyone has a school hoodie.
